Board Policy provides for transportation services to all eligible students attending the school serviced by their attendance boundary or the program in which they are enrolled. A student who lives beyond 1½ miles from the school is considered eligible for transportation services. *Students who live within 1½ miles, but are required to cross a main road such as 22 Mile, Garfield, Romeo Plank, Heydenreich, etc. without benefit of a traffic signal may also be considered eligible for transportation. Eligible students living on main roads with no sidewalk access to the nearest bus stop are picked up at their homes upon request only.*

Transportation to the IAM will be provided via the regular High School bus and/or shuttle bus servicing your neighborhood. Your bus stop will be commensurate with the high school students in your neighborhood. Transportation Services home will be via a dedicated IAM bus to centralized bus stops.

We understand that not all students who are eligible for Transportation Services choose to take advantage of those services; therefore, in order to create the most efficient bus routes, it is critical for us to know which eligible students will be riding the bus. **Please complete the form below and return it to the school office no later than the last Friday of the school year.** For those students who are involved in Athletics and will not ride during the season, or will otherwise only ride during certain times of the year, please complete this form as well. ***If your transportation requirements change during the year, please notify us by submitting a new form.***

SAFETY, ORDER & RIGHTS

SAFETY

- Stay seated at all times.
- Remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Keep all parts of your body inside the bus.
- No throwing anything, either on the bus or out the window.
- Do not touch any mechanisms, switches, or emergency doors and windows.

ORDER

- Cooperate with the driver; your safety is our main concern.
- No yelling or loud noises.
- No eating, drinking or smoking.
- Do not litter, write on or damage the bus in any way.

RIGHTS

- No fighting or pushing.
- Be courteous.
- No put-downs or vulgar language.



CONSEQUENCES

1. Verbal warnings.
2. Conference with bus driver.
3. Driver issued consequences.
4. Ticket – Signature of Parent and Principal required.
5. Possible suspension of transportation privileges.

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
