


IB Diploma Programme 🚯



The International Baccalaureate curriculum is the heart of the IAM's demanding academic program. All levels of the IB programme include a challenging liberal arts and science course of study. Students are required to take classes and assessments in six subject areas, write an extended essay of 4,000 words, take two Theory of Knowledge courses, and complete a minimum of 150 house of participation in creativity, activity and service (CAS) activities. The course of study and the IB diploma and subject area certificates are widely accepted by universities and colleges around the world as evidence of superior achievement
